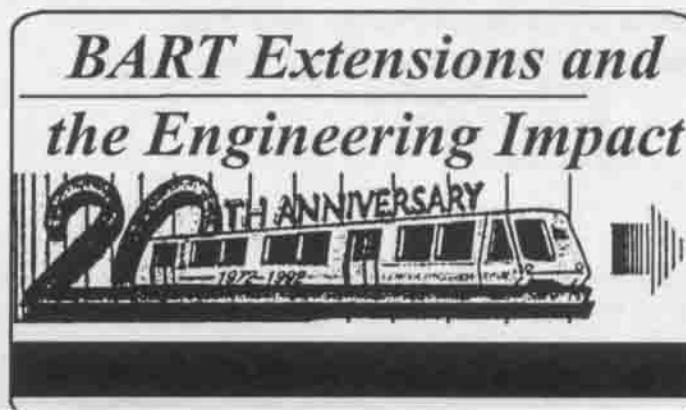

As BART enters the next stage of expansion there has been a lot of media attention. We are going to hear what BART is doing from two of the engineers involved in the expansion projects. Marvin's presentation will begin with an overview of each project. He will discuss the funding issues, problems with land acquisition and the engineering / construction schedules. He will also talk about a program to rehabilitate several original stations and many of the cars. Raymond will share with us some of the engineering problems associated with the expansion and daily operations.

Marvin is Supervising Project Engineer for the Dublin / Pleasanton extension. He has been with BART for 15 years, including 10 as Chief of the Engineering Civil Section. He has also worked with the State in CALTRANS and Bay Toll Crossings. He has a BSCE from the University of California at Berkeley.

Raymond is Manager of Electrical / Mechanical Engineering. He has a BSME, also from Berkeley, and is a Professional Mechanical and Electrical Engineer. He is a member of the Mt. Diablo Section of ASME.
